**Editor's note: Donny Pauling is a former, highly successful porn producer. He left the industry after experiencing a dramatic conversion..**

November 8, 2012 (DonnyPauling.com) - When I speak, I have a goal to open up everything I've got, pouring my heart out and giving away all emotional energy to the audience. At the end of the time I talk I'm almost always exhausted, but happy. My style isn't to "preach" at people, but rather share the mistakes I've made and what I've learned from them. Each listener is free to eat the meat and spit out the bones: take what applies to them, toss what does not. I'm convinced this is what God wants me to do.

Prior to taking the stage, I have the same very simple prayer I pray: "Your words, God. Your words." I want to share the things He wants me to share, and nothing more. I'll never doubt the passage in scripture where we're told He can use *all* things for good... because I see the truth in that passage every single time He gives me the opportunity to share what He's done in my life. Not long ago, I produced a product that tore lives apart in numerous ways. Now, He uses those experiences to start processes that put marriages back together, free people from perversion, even bring people to the place where they surrender their lives to Him for the first time. It's sometimes so overwhelming that I literally sit in my hotel room and cry joyfully afterwards. I look in the mirror and can't understand why the face I see is one He's chosen to use to do this. It's very humbling.

I'm very blunt in what I say, and try to be "real". This often results in people sharing things with me that they've likely never told anyone... or at most very few others. For example, in one church a man walked up afterwards and asked to talk a bit. He needed to know how to forgive himself. The conversation started with something like, "After hearing what you said this morning, I'll bet you've heard everything." I nodded my head affirmatively to encourage him to say what he needed to say. He proceeded to tell me things he'd done to animals. Inside I thought, "Well *now* I've heard everything... I guess I hadn't before!"

As I listened to his story, I learned he was deep in counseling and had come clean with his wife, who'd forgiven him. The major issue he faced was forgiving himself. To be honest, I didn't much feel like talking to him. My stomach felt a little queasy. I was shocked and a little angry at the things he'd said. But I also had to remind myself that plenty of people feel the same way towards me when I share some of the things I've done. I kept praying silently in my mind while he spoke, asking God for words to give to this man. When the words come from HIM, I can tell by watching the face of the person I share them with – faces light up... that's the best way I know how to describe it.

I reaffirmed a few things he'd told me: "You've asked God for forgiveness? You've been forgiven by your wife? You've been in counseling, and are continuing with that?" The first question is really the only one that mattered, yet each of them was answered with a 'yes', and I felt God wanted me to tell him this:

"God has given you an amazing present, gift wrapped with a beautiful bow on top of it. Inside the package is something called 'grace'. If you can't let go of this guilt it's like you're pushing God's gift back at Him and telling Him you don't like it... that it's not good enough for you. Just accept his present, my friend." The huge smile on his face let me know this is indeed what God wanted him to hear. The thing is, I also needed to hear those words, as I sometimes have problems forgiving myself, too. *Funny how God works like that.*

One morning after speaking, a good-looking teenage boy came up to talk to me. He was very real with me when he told me about his struggles with sex: "I don't have a girlfriend, but lots of girls like me so I sleep around a lot. It's fun, but I know it's not God's ideal for me. How do I stop?" As always, I mentally asked God what to share with him as he spoke. I could tell this kid was a bit on the aggressive side, and fist fights were probably something with which he was familiar.

I asked, "If you did have a girlfriend, I bet you'd be willing to fight for her, wouldn't you?" His chest inflated, masculine posturing at its finest. "Of course!" he grinned.

"Well, in fist fights wounds heal quickly. Black eyes go away. In a few days it's not a big deal anymore, and nothing to brag about. But what if you could fight a REAL fight... one that IS worth bragging about? Let's say it's two years from now when God brings into your life the woman of your dreams. Right now, with all the sleeping around you're doing, you don't really have anything special to offer her, sexually. But what if you could walk up to her and tell her, 'The last two years I've been fighting the hardest battle of my life for you, for the thought of you, and I didn't know you yet'? Isn't THAT a fight worth winning? Keeping yourself sexually pure for her is the way you fight."

A smile spread across his face. I challenged him to fight a battle that would actually test his worth as a man... to see as God's daughters the girls who were so easily ready to give him what wasn't his to take, and to fight for them, too, even when they weren't willing to fight for themselves. When a girl threw herself at him, he could truly be a Knight in Shining Armor if he turned the opportunity aside, reminding himself that she isn't his... that God has someone special for him (and for her) if he'd just wait patiently. They say every man needs a battle, and his would be fought not just for himself, but for all the girls willing to sell out so cheaply for a bit of his attention. He got it.

I try to remind myself of similar things when I walk around. I try to make a habit of bouncing my eyes up to the face of a beautiful woman, and often repeat "not mine" in my head or even verbally. She's not mine. God has her set aside. She's not mine. She's His little girl, and she needs me to fight for her by keeping my eyes where they should be. Her Daddy God is always watching, and I really don't want Him catching me visually molesting her. Any animal is capable of giving in to lust. Be a man, Donny. Be a real man.

I remind myself of these things often, and each successful battle fought brings more strength for winning the war.

## ***I was pro-choice, and then I had an abortion***

*Editor's Note: The author of this article has requested to be identified as Abby. Here is her personal story.*

February 8, 2013 (LiveActionNews.org) - I am 26 years old, working as a weather forecaster in Washington, D.C. I have experienced a traumatizing medical abortion and am a recent convert to the pro-life movement.

At the start of my college career, I got involved in women's right groups with my friends and strongly supported abortion for all women at their discretion. I saw nothing wrong with someone wanting to pursue all the opportunities that she could. My view has changed dramatically after my own personal experience:

A year ago I went to an OBGYN and said I needed a termination of pregnancy. I was "only" six weeks pregnant, but at 25 I had no job, and my parents couldn't really afford to look after me, so I decided that termination would be the most appropriate course of action.

My boyfriend had no opinion either way, and I didn't tell anyone else. The doctor was quite cheerful, examined me, and was all too helpful to do blood tests and explain the abortion-inducing pill procedure without even mentioning counseling, talking to a friend, or asking about my mental health. This pill is claimed to be the "safest" and "most convenient" method for early termination. I thought, "Great, it's all over in three days!" and went on my merry way.

First pill down, no side effects. Forty-eight hours later, time for second pill. One hour after that, I was screaming and crying, writhing in agony on the floor. I couldn't move; I was on the verge of passing out; I couldn't even see – blinded by the pain.

My boyfriend picked me up and rushed me to the emergency room, where I waited, still sobbing and thrashing with pain. When the triage doctor finally saw me, my blood pressure was dangerously low, and my heart rate was all over the chart. When I told him about the abortion, he callously said that I would be "fine" and pricked me with a needle to jolt my blood pressure higher – but still dramatically low. I was sick for two more days, drugged up on the heavy-duty painkillers that the ER doctor had prescribed for me.

When I returned to the OBGYN a week later and told him about my ordeal and severe reaction, he just looked at me questioningly and said, "You seem all right; you didn't bleed out." No sympathy, no concern.

These "convenient," "safe," and "easy" medical abortions are downright dangerous. After researching (which I admittedly should have done beforehand), I have found that there is nothing "safe" about them – hemorrhage, massive drop in blood pressure, and shock are just some of the plethora of side effects.

My agonizing experience, not to mention the intense guilt I still feel (for I'm sure the baby was in agony as well), has made me realize that abortions do nothing more than hurt the mother *and* the baby.

I no longer believe that abortion is "pro-woman." It only serves to burden our minds and hurt our bodies. If the doctor had recommended counseling, or if I had spoken to my parents, I am almost sure that I would have kept my baby.

## **North Dakota is on the verge of becoming the first state in the union to pass personhood legislation into law.** BY John Jalsevac

BISMARCK, ND, February 7, 2013, (LifeSiteNews.com) - North Dakota may be on the verge of becoming the first state in the union that protects human beings from the moment of conception after the Senate passed the state's personhood amendment.

Jennifer Mason, spokesperson for Personhood USA, told LifeSiteNews.com in a telephone interview that she believes the legislation has a very good chance of passing the House and being signed by the governor.

"We just need the North Dakota House of Representatives to stay strong and vote as they did before," she said, "and we'll see this pass for the first time in the United States"

The amendment, SCR 4009, states, "the inalienable right to life of every human being at any stage of development must be recognized and protected."

In addition, the Senate has approved SB 2303 which "ensures that the protection that our criminal laws afford to victims of crimes extends to all human beings born and unborn."

"North Dakota is leading the way for equal rights and protections for all human beings," said Mason

"Abortion laws are archaic, based on 40-year-old science and technology," added Mason.

"Our understanding of pregnancy and human development since Roe v Wade has changed dramatically. There is no question now that the unborn child is a human being and a person, who has a right to legal recognition and protection."

....won his first Super Bowl earlier this year....he was adopted as a practically homeless teen...Oher's adoptive mother, Leigh Anne Tuohy, put her heart into words: "Families don't have to match...you don't have to look like someone else to love them. We believe that there are no unwanted kids, just unfound families."

Steve Jobs, former CEO of Apple

...Jobs would never have had his chance at revolutionizing technology had his birth mother not given him the gift of life.....Jobs's mother...placed her baby boy with a family who would raise him and encourage his inventiveness.

Faith Hill, country music star

Faith Hill was adopted just days after her birth by a Mississippi couple with two biological sons. Her song "Mississippi Girl" pays tribute to a childhood she calls "amazing"... "I have a lot of respect for my birth mother and no feelings of anger or any of that, she has said. "I know she must have had a lot of love for me to want to give me what she felt was a better chance."

Dave Thomas, founder of Wendy's

Dave Thomas was adopted at birth and had already begun working in the restaurant business before he had finished high school. Adoption was such a blessing in Thomas's life that he returned the favour, thousands of times over. The Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption and Wendy's Wonderful Kids (which specifically serves kids currently in foster care) has helped over 3,400 children get adopted. Wendy's also sponsors "A Home For the Holidays", a CBS special that airs every year at Christmas and helps children get placed in adoptive families.

Jamie Foxx, Academy Award-winning actor

...He has been quite vocal about the life lessons his beloved grandmother (also his adoptive mother) taught him. Foxx has appeared on "A Home for the Holidays" and is outspoken about the need for adoption in the U.S.

John Hancock, signer of the Declaration of Independence, governor, and president of Congress

...After the death of Hancock's father, his uncle chose to raise him as his own son...Hancock clearly went on to lead a successful life of leadership, becoming one of the greatest political leaders and Founding Fathers of America.

Rodney Atkins, country music star

...His birth mother became pregnant with him after "a traumatic first date," but she still chose to give life to her son....Atkins...has used his platform...the role of a spokesman for the National Council for Adoption. He has chosen to speak out so that other children might be given the same chance he was given and so that other mothers might make the same sacrifice that his made. Atkins has used his music career to raise \$5,000,000 for the children's home he lived at before his adoption. His own website tells about his involvement in the lives of the home's needy children.

McKenna, Snowflake baby

...Adopted as an embryo, McKenna was implanted into the womb of her adoptive mother and born nine months later....featured on the cover of Adoption Today. Snowflake adoption is being brought to light these days, as more and more babies are being adopted from OVF clinics and born into new families. Nightlight Christian Adoptions is on the forefront of this modern adoption choice.

# Janet Morana recalls abortion's painful impact

Bryan Kemper of Stand True Ministries and Priests for Life recently interviewed Janet Morana about her new book, *Recall Abortion*.

**Q:** In your book, you note that the statistics and facts regarding the dangers of abortion are often covered up or even faked by pro-choice organizations. How can we encourage the secular media to expose these lies about abortion?

**A:** We need to continue to speak the truth and challenge the media to report on abortion in a fair and unbiased and balanced way.

**Q:** Your book is unique in that it focuses primarily on the damage that abortion does to women. What prompted you to take this approach?

**A:** The many years working in the pro-life movement and especially my work with The Silent No More Awareness Campaign, which I co-founded and Rachel's Vineyard, the largest international abortion recovery program has taught me first hand the damage that abortion has done to women, men, families and society as a whole.

**Q:** Recall Abortion discusses the topic of IVF and how it so often leads to selective abortion in the case of multiple babies. How can we best show compassion to those couples struggling with infertility while at the same time condemning the evils associated with certain fertility treatments?

**A:** It is unnecessary to go down the IVF road. Instead there is a science called Naprotechnology which examines the physical reasons a couple is having difficulty conceiving a child. Sometimes corrective surgery on the woman and medications assist the couple in conceiving without using IVF.

**Q:** What can parents do to teach their daughters that abortion is not the answer to unplanned pregnancy?

**A:** You begin when they are young instilling in them values about the sanctity of life. Also letting them know that no matter what mistakes they might make they can always come to their parents.

**Q:** Your approach to post-abortive women is not one of anger or judgment, but of loving compassion. Do you think that enough people show compassion to these women, or that enough support is offered for women to decide not to abort their children?

**A:** No, society at large and the abortion industry still bill abortion as a simple procedure, have your abortion today and go back to work or school tomorrow. So when these women leave the clinic not feeling like it was no big deal but instead have feelings of grief and guilt, they feel like no one understands them and they feel isolated.

Also for a woman who decides not to abort her child, there is plenty of help with the pregnancy resource centers but the sad thing is that many women do not know these centers exist. ROME, February 6, 2013 ([LifeSiteNews.com](http://LifeSiteNews.com)) - The assertion by Mother Theresa of Calcutta that abortion is the "greatest threat to peace in the world" has become proverbial in the pro-life world. In 1985, she reiterated and expanded on the point in an interview with New York journalist and pro-life activist Thom O'Connor that, until recently, has been almost unknown. In the O'Connor interview, which is now publicly available after being [uploaded onto Youtube](#), Mother Teresa explained that the unborn child, is created "in the image of God for greater things, to love and be loved. That is why it is such a terrible thing to think that the mother, to whom the child has been given as a gift of God, could destroy it."

"That's why I think that abortion has become the greatest destroyer of peace today because it destroys the life of the child, but also destroys the conscience of the mother also, and for years and years, she knows that she has murdered her own child," she said.

The famed humanitarian called it "something unbelievable" that the "mother can murder her own child."

She recalled meeting one woman who had aborted her child eight years previous, and who told Mother Teresa that "every time she meets a child of eight years old, she remembers, 'My child would be this age now if I didn't kill it.'"

O'Connor spoke about his experience of interviewing the woman that many believed at the time was a living saint. "Her personality and warm presence are so powerful, so commanding, that her gentle humility quietly radiates throughout her entire being," he said.

In the interview Mother Theresa spoke briefly of her work among the "poorest of the poor" in India and elsewhere, and noted that abortion is less common among those with less material wealth.

"Something very strange is that the poor people are not destroying their children, the unborn child," she said. "It is the better-off people who want something else and are afraid of the little one. So they destroy the child.

"But the very poor people are not doing that. We have seen it again and again in every place where our sisters are working." She praised the "great tenderness and generosity" of young people, saying that "sometimes they are misled and they cannot choose rightly. But once they are put in touch with the poor, and they touch Christ in the distressing disguise of the poor, immediately they think, 'Yes, I've found Him. I love Him. I want to serve Him.'"
