Actress Scarlett Johansson Designs New T-Shirt for Planned Parenthood Abortion Biz

Actress Scarlett Johansson has designed a new t-shirt for the nation's largest abortion business, Planned Parenthood. The shirts are meant to raise funds for the abortion giant's political group as it prepares to launch an advertising campaign to trash pro-life candidates.

The campaign is also responding to the Supreme Court's decision protecting Hobby Lobby and other pro-life-run businesses that do not want to be forced to pay for abortion-causing drugs for their employees.

"When I heard that some politicians were cheering the Supreme Court's decision to give bosses the right to interfere in our access to birth control, I thought I had woken up in another decade," said Johansson in a statement.

Johansson, who has starred in Hollywood hits including *Iron Man* and *Lost in Translation*, designed the shirt to help the pro-abortion-rights group's political arm raise money for its "Women are Watching" campaign.

The campaign intends to target candidates who support the high court's *Hobby Lobby* ruling. The Supreme Court allowed "closely held" companies with religious objections to opt out of covering birth control for employees under ObamaCare.

The pink T-shirts designed by Johansson read, "Hey Politicians! The 1950s called ..." on the front. On the back, the shirts say: "They want their sexism back!" Text on the left sleeve is signed, "Love Scarlett Johansson."

"Women will be the key to the elections this November and it's more important than ever that young women register to vote and vote for the candidate that will stand up and fight for them," said Johansson.

Actress Gabrielle Union, along with Natasha Lyonne and Selenis Leyva, the stars of the Netflix series "Orange is the New Black," are set to release their own T-shirts for Planned Parenthood in the next two months. (excerpt: LifeNews.com | 8/26/14)

SIX WAYS CONTRACEPTIVES DENY WOMEN CONTROL OF THEIR BODIES

(EXCERPT FROM LifeSite News 25/08/14)

The modern world proclaims contraceptives to be the saviour of womankind. Abortion groups, politicians, and millions of tax dollars push the idea that without contraceptives, women will not be able to have control of their bodies.

However, scientific evidence abounds that contraception use may negatively impact the power women have over their bodies. Consider the following:

1. A recent study found that use of some forms of contraception are linked to greater odds of breast cancer. The study found that the use of moderate doses of estrogen in contraceptives increased the odds of breast cancer by "1.6-fold." The less-popular high-estrogen dose contraceptives increased the odds of breast cancer by "2.7-fold."

The World Health Organization also considers the pill a Group 1 carcinogen.

2. Contraception proponents regularly push the idea that more contraception equals a better sex life. However, a study in 2005 found that the pill may very well reduce sex drive and libido.

3. A study released in July found that there may be increased risk of gestational diabetes when taking oral contraceptives.

4. While the maker of the intravaginal device NuVaRing says the risk is extremely small, blood clots and VTE are side effects of using NuVaRing. Famously, 2014 Olympic hopeful Megan Henry was forced to miss the Olympics because of the effect NuVaRing had on her lungs.

5. The FDA has approved what the Obama administration says are contraceptive drugs and devices. However, Health & Human Services - one of the many agencies the administration oversees - admits that at least one of the devices approved by the FDA ends the life of an unborn child. A further wealth of evidence shows that 4 of the 20 contraceptives approved by the FDA either are, or may be, abortifacients.

In other words, the word "contraceptive," which means "to prevent pregnancy," to fool women into thinking they are merely preventing the fertilization of an egg and sperm when in fact they may be killing their already-conceived children.

6. The deaths of dozens of women around the world have been linked to the use of various contraceptives. Those deaths have led to lawsuits against major pharmaceutical companies, including many who Megan Henry joined when she sued Merck.

Long before modern contraceptives and abortifacients came into existence, the Catholic Church promoted Natural Family Planning after marriage and sexual abstinence until marriage. But it hardly requires belief in the Church's teachings to see that artificial birth control and abortion drugs and devices aren't the panacea proponents claim that they are.

3 ways to defend your conservative beliefs, AND still have friends afterwards

• Always ask questions.

Anyone who has taken a pro-life training course will not be surprised to hear that the Socratic Method is always the best. When I was confronted by university friends and peers on some of my perspectives that they found downright incredible, questions were always helpful. One friend demanded to know why I wasn't sleeping around. I responded with a question: "How many of the people that you were with do you wish you hadn't hooked up with?" After a pause, the thoughtful response: "Most of them, I guess. Maybe even all of them."

• Always see whoever you're debating with as a person first.

I know it seems trite and perhaps a bit precious, but it's absolutely true. I remember watching a documentary on the battle over Proposition 8 in California, where gay marriage proponents and opponents screamed at each other in the streets, unstoppable force meeting immovable object.

However, when you discuss things with people instead of placards, it's amazing how the relationships that form can help others question some of their perspectives.

We see this all the time debating abortion—once people realize that you're not going to yell at them, that you just want to chat, and that you're not judgemental monsters who are there to condemn them, they calm down. One pro-choice protestor screamed at me for ten minutes. Eventually, however, we had a three hour conversation that resulted in her tearing up her own sign. Once I was no longer a protestor but a person, she had to take me more seriously. She just had to realize that pro-lifers were people before she could grasp that pre-born children, are, too.

• Don't get angry

Trust me, I know this one is difficult sometimes. At university, I failed this one multiple times. But if you choose to engage—and you should—on cultural issues like abortion or pornography or sexual ethics in general, where people's views are often rooted in their own experiences and those of people that they love, staying calm is essential. As defensive as you might be when your principles are under attack, always remember that the people you are discussing or arguing with are probably just as defensive as you are.

The biblical book of Proverbs informs us, "A soft answer turneth away wrath." Better advice in our current culture wars could not possibly be given. That doesn't mean we compromise on truth, and it doesn't mean that there isn't a time for "righteous indignation" in defence of our beliefs. But in the context of a one-on-one conversation with a peer, many of whom will try to bait you, this advice is essential. Keep your cool, and you might be surprised at how productive your conversations will turn out.

In summation, I always think of my discussions with university peers in the terms of one of *Aesop's Fables*. The Wind and the Sun were debating as to which was the strongest, and decided to have a contest to resolve the issue. They decided to see which one of them could cause a man walking down the road to take off his cloak. The Wind howled and blew and whipped around the man, who only clung to his cloak all the harder and pulled it around him, until the Wind finally gave up in despair. The Sun simply shone brighter and warmer until the man relinquished his cloak and took it off. We have a chance on campuses to have real, meaningful discussions with our peers on the issues that matter the most. And we should.

... His early days back in San Francisco after dropping out of Julliard (in the mid 1970's) were among the unhappiest of his life. His relationship with his girlfriend, which had seemed so full of promise back in New York, had now come to a sudden and abrupt end...In an interview in Playboy magazine some years later, the subject turned to the Bush administration's stance on abortion...Williams offered that making the decision to have an abortion was not an easy one, which begged the obvious question from interviewer Lawrence Grobel about whether he had ever found himself in that position.

'Long, long, long time ago,' Williams replied candidly, 'and it was because we were too young and it wasn't right.' (Pg 35)

Passion of the Christ Actor Jim Caviezel Calls Abortion America's "Great Sin"

Jim Caviezel, famed for his role as Christ in *The Passion of the Christ*, and currently starring as the leading man in TV's *Person of Interest*, is frequently outspoken on the issue of abortion. With his publicly Catholic faith to his committed pro-life views, Jim and his wife Kerri have adopted two children from China, both of whom had special needs.

Earlier this year, Caviezel had a message about God's mercy and grace — especially for women who have had abortions. Now he has a message for Americans in general: calling abortion America's "great sin."

The Christian Post has more:

"Many people are a part of this great sin in this country. These are all God's children and he brings them home. Now He wants to bring you home. Do you think your friend has more grace than God? Does your friend have more love than the Creator? It can never be. God forgives you and now He needs you to begin, to accept forgiveness," the actor told the congregation at Rock Church in San Diego, WND.com reported earlier this week.

"Some of you have had abortions – some men here, and women are adulterers," Caviezel said during a question and answer session at the church.

"Some have committed murder. Some of you didn't have the abortion but paid for it, so you have contributed to this. Many people are part of this great sin in this country ... over 50 million in the United States alone, and 45 million die every year in the world. These are all God's children and God brings them home."

Caviezel isn't worried about how being outspoken on abortion may impact his career.

The actor told Catholic Digest in 2009 that being pro-life is more important to him than his career. He told the digest, "How are we so arrogant to think the 51.5 million babies who have died in this country... Look, I am for helping women. I just don't see abortion as helping women. And I don't love my career that much to say, 'I'm going to remain silent on this.'"
