THE BIRTH CONTROL PILL IS KILLING WOMEN, BUT NO ONE'S WARNING THEM OF THE RISK

May 7, 2015 (*STOPP.org*) -- The young newlywed put herself at risk for collapse, stroke, heart attack, and death every day when she popped her birth control pill. Tragically, she had no idea there was any danger. Even medical personnel thought her symptoms were no big deal, and on more than one occasion chalked her symptoms up to dehydration. They never told her it could be that her contraception was causing blood clots.

Her name was Kate. She was a 28-year-old business woman whose story is told in "What Every Woman Needs to Know about Blood Clots" posted on the National Blood Clot Alliance "Stop the Clot" website. Kate's symptoms started while she was in Hawaii on her honeymoon. She suffered pain in her calf that was so intense it woke her up at night. She went to an orthopedic surgeon, who ordered scans, found no problems, and dismissed her. She forgot about it. Seven months later she passed out in an airport following a flight. Medical personnel said she was dehydrated.

Completely unknown to her, Kate had developed deep vein thrombosis in her calf. From there, blood clots began breaking off and going to her lungs. These blood clots in the lungs, called pulmonary emboli, "can be life-threatening and in 10-15 percent of cases, cause sudden death," according to Dr. Jack Ansell. Dr. Ansell is a hematologist and member of the National Blood Clot Alliance's Medical & Scientific Advisory Board. The Alliance website goes on to quote Dr. Ansell: "The first sign of a PE can be death."

Thanks to Kate's mother, a nurse, who suggested that she might have pulmonary emboli, Kate got help and did not die. She caught it before it killed her. Many other women are not so lucky. They don't learn the truth until it is too late.

The truth is, "(t)he relative risk for thrombosis in patients who take COCs [combined oral contraceptives] is three- to five-fold higher compared with that of nonusers." Thrombosis means blood clots that can cause stroke, heart attack, blindness, brain damage, and death. Still, women are not warned about the risk of blood clots with their daily steroidal hormone pill. This is serious and senseless deception and negligence.

According to a Canadian Broadcasting Company report in June 2013, birth control pill manufacturer Bayer paid out in excess of \$1 billion to settle thousands of birth control pill lawsuits in the United States. Those settlements were all related to two low-dose contraception pills, Yaz and Yasmin. At the same time, an investigation by the CBC revealed that pharmacists suspected the deaths of 23 Canadian women were attributable to those two same pills.

Miranda Scott, only 18, was working out at the University of British Columbia gym when she fell over backward and died. Her autopsy showed that she died of blood clots throughout her body. She was taking Yasmin at the time of her death. Her mother is now part of a Canadian class action lawsuit against the drug manufacturer, along with hundreds of family members and women who have been harmed or killed by the pill.

Yet, even as Bayer pays out huge settlements, it says it "stands by" its birth control products. Even Elizabeth Kissling, writing for the radical feminist magazine *Ms*, is troubled by the cover-up and lack of education and testing women are given before being prescribed the pill.

"Today . . . young women are again dying from something purported to help them, something that affects mostly women. Thousands more are experiencing life-threatening, health-destroying side-effects, such as blindness, depression, and pulmonary embolism," Kissling said, citing accounts of young women who had suffered all these consequences.

She referenced a first-person account posted on xojane.com, that highlighted this shocking quote by a young woman who almost died from pulmonary embolism caused by her birth control pill. "Isn't this bizarre?" [the young woman] asked doctors in the hospital. They shook their heads and informed me that **they regularly encountered otherwise healthy young women with blood clots, almost all caused by birth control.**

The pill kills truth. It exists and is prescribed to women amid a swirl of chaos; amidst contradictions and lies; and amidst dead, blind, and profoundly injured women. Prescribing doctors tell women birth control is perfectly safe if they don't smoke. Emergency room doctors tell women they "regularly encounter otherwise healthy young women with blood clots, almost all caused by birth control." Billions of dollars are paid out by drug companies to settle lawsuits, while they say they still stand by their contraceptive pills.

THE ABORTION DEBATE TURNS SMART PEOPLE INTO IDIOTS. HERE'S ONE WAY TO OVERCOME THAT. BY JONATHON VAN MAREN

The problem,” people often tell me, “is not that people don’t know what abortion is. It’s that they don’t understand the beauty of the pre-born child. They don’t know that the baby in the womb is a baby.”

I understand what they’re trying to say. **The dehumanizing rhetoric of the pro-choice movement has been staggeringly effective.** Clump of cells, parasite, sub-human—as with every injustice, insidious propaganda must be applied to the victim in order to ease the consciences of those involved in the killing.

Everyone, I think, knows both instinctively if not intellectually that the pre-born child in the womb is in fact a human being. It’s why when someone announces that they’re “expecting,” no one asks them what they’re expecting. Or when someone goes to the hospital to give birth, no one feels the need to check and see what they gave birth to—because they all know.

The problem is that our culture is suffering from a cognitive dissonance. Cognitive dissonance is the state of holding two contradictory or competing ideas at the same time, without reconciling those beliefs. This is precisely what has happened with abortion: What we instinctively and intellectually know about the pre-born child in the womb does not line up with what we culturally believe about abortion.

Any pro-life activist can tell you that when you’re discussing the abortion issue with a pro-choice person, they become suddenly and mysteriously amnesiac when you start asking them questions like, “So what is it that’s developing in the mother’s womb?” If a friend had just excitedly announced a pregnancy to them, there would be no confusion about the baby in the womb. But in the cultural context of abortion, suddenly intelligent people turn into idiots, and begin stuttering about “partly human” or “potential human” or “maybe possibly will become human.”

That’s why so many pro-life strategies often prove ineffective. Showing them a picture of a born child, for example, doesn’t force them to confront any hard truth or even make them re-examine their worldview. So it is often with pictures of pre-born children in the womb, too—they see the picture, the register it, and it confirms what they already know—that the baby in the womb is, in fact, a baby. What we need is information, is evidence, that directly targets their cognitive dissonance—that attacks the mental wall between what they know about the baby in the womb and what they believe about abortion.

That is why I think abortion victim photography is so essential: Because in one, often horrifying image, the viewer is forced to reconcile what they knew all along about the child in the womb—that it was a tiny human being—with what abortion actually is, a brutal act of violence that physically destroys that tiny human being. Pictures of abortion victims bring down that mental wall, and the controversy surrounding the use of abortion victim photography exists precisely because of the reaction that often results from people struggling to reconcile two separate ideas which, for the first time, they are realizing are horrifyingly incompatible.

We see the stunned realization that abortion is a brutal act of violence even in what some people say. “That’s a picture of a slain baby!” one stunned woman told a TV anchor after receiving one of our anti-abortion postcards. One reporter I spoke with asked how we felt about younger people seeing the images, and as I was pointing that even in Grade 6 and 7 graphic imagery is used to dissuade drug use, smoking, and drinking and driving, the reporter interrupted me by saying, “Yes—but your images show dead infants, and that hits people harder.”

It does—and for precisely the reason the reporter, however inadvertently, pointed out: It is impossible not to recognize that these images are, in fact, of dead children. Worse, they are killed children. That is never going to be a popular thing to point out. But it does cut to the heart of the issue like nothing else does—and it makes the truth about abortion unavoidable.

The truth is a hard one, especially in a culture that has sealed its covenant with the abortion industry with the blood of millions. Pro-lifers who seek a way to change the culture without confrontation or by self-censoring our best evidence of the truth about abortion have to realize that the guilt of our culture runs wide and deep—for every one of those million lives snuffed out, there was—is—two parents of a dead child. Four grandparents. Friends who applauded or suggested the idea that the life be ended. The medical staff who performed the procedure. The boyfriend, husband, partner who may have pressured or coerced, or even simply driven his partner and his child to a clinic where that child would be shredded and discarded.

But only a recognition of what abortion actually is will heal our culture, because only with recognition, only with truth, can there be repentance, without which there can be no healing. We know the truth. Millions don’t. It’s up to us to confront them with the evidence that will destroy the deadly cognitive dissonance that is resulting in so much death.

21 year old dies after taking birth control pill

Twenty-one-year-old Fallan Kurek died of a pulmonary embolism, caused by a birth control pill – Rigevidon – that she had been taking for less than a month. Tragically, Kurek had been directed by her doctor to take the pill solely for the purpose of regulating her period.

The Daily Mail [reports](#):

She had been taking the medication for just 25 days when she collapsed at home in Tamworth, Staffordshire.

Paramedics rushed to her house after she began vomiting – but minutes later she stopped breathing and turned blue.

Tragically, after three days in intensive care, she was pronounced brain dead.

She passed away just hours later on Thursday May 14, surrounded by her loved ones.

Her cause of death was recorded as pulmonary embolism (blood clot) on her lung.

Kurek’s chest pain had been checked out at a hospital four days prior to her collapse. Sadly, her pain was dismissed and the cause went unrecognized. It seems medical professionals did not ask if Kurek was taking any form of birth control until she was already on a ventilator.

At that point, staff at the hospital realized that she was likely suffering from a blood clot, but the damage had already been done. Kurek’s parents question why they were not informed of the danger of blood clots. **This danger is three times higher among women who are on hormonal birth control pills than among women who are not.**

Despite this fact, a spokesman from the U.K.’s Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency says that “the benefits of any combined hormonal contraceptive far outweigh the risk of serious side effects.” Yet this begs the question of whether a triple risk of possible death is truly worth a regulated period – especially when other options are available, though perhaps not as quick of a “fix.”

Kurek’s parents hope that telling their daughter’s story can bring attention to the real risks of birth control pills.

Mr and Mrs Kurek also hope that medical professionals will take more time to explain serious side effects to all women, not just those in high risk groups, such as smokers or overweight women.

‘They know the pill can cause blood clots,’ said Mr Kurek. ‘We can’t bring her back, all we can do is maybe save another life.’

Even *Cosmopolitan* agrees that Kurek’s story is both terribly sad and scary for women:

If you think an unplanned pregnancy or an irregular period is scary, this should put things in perspective: 21-year-old Australian Fallan Kurek recently died from taking birth control pills, which triggered a lung blood clot and heart inflammation, reports *Birmingham Mail*. She’d only been on the pill for 25 days.

Hannah McCann, another young woman, is speaking out about the dangers of birth control pills after suffering from a blood clot herself:

Hannah McCann said she was the “lucky one” after reading about the death of 21-year-old Fallan Kurek from Staffordshire in England who suffered a fatal blood clot after she was prescribed the same contraceptive pill. ...

Hannah, also 21, was prescribed Rigevidon in December to regulate her periods after being diagnosed with Polycystic Ovary Syndrome in October last year.

Just 21 days after starting to take the contraceptive pill, Hannah fell ill and doctors discovered she had a blood clot on the brain. She said doctors have since told her Rigevidon was the most likely cause of the clot.

In January 2014, Vanity Fair released an expose on the Nuva Ring, another non-pill form of hormonal birth control. Devastating results have been discovered in women using the Nuva Ring, too – including death from pulmonary embolisms.

While hormonal birth control is known to act by stripping the lining of a woman’s uterus, sometimes causing early miscarriages, it is also undoubtedly dangerous to women themselves.

It’s high time women were given the complete facts about hormonal birth control (including hormonal and copper IUDs). They need to be aware of what can truly happen: the ending of the lives of their preborn babies as well as damage and destruction to their own bodies.
